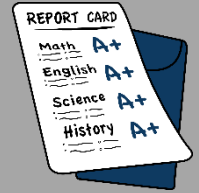

 - Permissions slips for this field trip went home earlier this week. Remember to **wear your Trinity blue** and to **bring a bag lunch**.

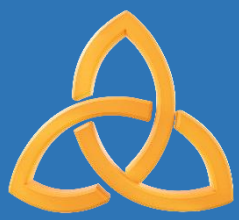


- **VIP/Grandparents Day: Wednesday, January 29th**

- **8:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m.:** Join us for chapel if you are able.



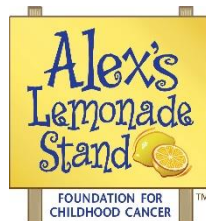
Kids Heart Challenge

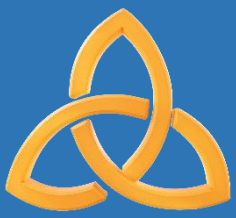

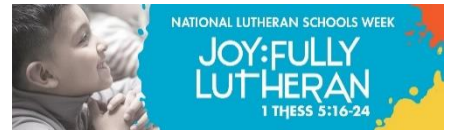

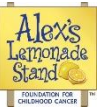


Lutheran Schools Week Next Week


