
#### K-8 School Picture Day on Monday

#### Other Ideas/Discussion:

Spending money of classroom funds? – approved providing teachers with \$100-\$200 for classrooms

Future spending - create a vision of what we want to promote in the classrooms – further discussion needed

We recognize need for marketing our school to increase enrollment – further discussion needed

- Religion – yes; but need to promote our academics and the importance of small class sizes

Bring back selling clothing items for parents & students? – *discuss via email* Other Idea: Create a sharing clothing area for used Trinity clothes

- Ideal for students leaving the school to offer Trinity clothing to new students

#### Joint Questions/Discussion with Board of Ed and School Board

#### **New Bus Discussion**

- Fits 55 passengers (current enrollment = 45 students)
- Cost \$28,000 (sell our current bus for approximately \$10,000 or trade?)
- 15 passenger van requires a CDL license regular license covers a 12-passenger van
- Current bus requires repairs (up to \$5,000) + DOT and winterization (\$2,000) = \$7,000
- Is there an option to contract busing? buses from district not option, limited schedule, or expensive (\$600/trip)
- Funding: split between 3 different groups (approx. \$10,000 from each group) balances below
- Auction account (\$22,770)

- School Wish (\$20,958)
- Day School Special (\$32,406 w/ \$13,000 for technology fees/Chromebook deposit)
- Voted that CPL would be willing to cover 1/3<sup>rd</sup> of new bus cost

#### Other Joint Questions/Discussion

- Admissions Committee Possible need to re-establish an admissions committee
- Marketing/Promotion Need for developing a marketing committee
- Nancy mentioned other schools hiring someone to help with school promotion (cost unknown)
- Temporary signage? (use temporary signs to promote school)
- New permanent sign (digital sign possible?) (need to go to city council for approval)
- Social Media promote what stands out about school?
- In process of switching over website (about 4 weeks to develop basic site)
- School Accreditation Committee (to be discussed by School Board) accreditation would create more options for grants/funding
- Linking CPL bank account to Facebook non-profit fundraising (approved by Board of Stewardship)
- Extra stuff being stored in gym work with Trustees to clear clutter
