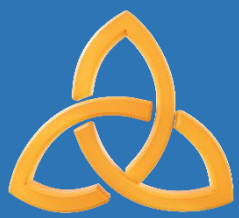
Online Silent Auction Starts Monday!

Trinity's ^{Optional} April STEM Club Challenge

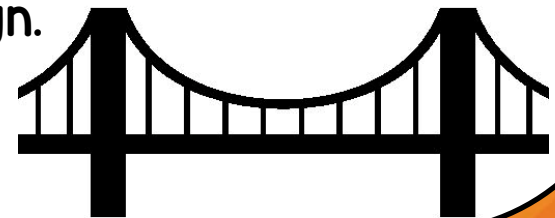
Challenge: Create a bridge that can be placed over the expanse of at least 1 foot and support weight.
