As our right now, a **tentative** date of **Tuesday, May 5th**, has been set as the return for in-person classroom learning. **The governor is expected to make an updated announcement regarding distance learning soon, so it is likely this may change.**

- **Friday, May 1st:** Last day of Distance Learning for Trinity's K-8 Student (We will be in session even though the ISD 15 district is not.)
- **Monday, May 4th:** Supplies Drop Off Day, **No** Distance Learning (School will be open for anyone needing to drop off their child's supplies as we get ready to resume classroom learning.)
- **Tuesday, May 5th:** In-Person Classes Resume

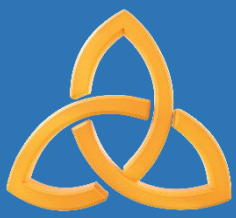

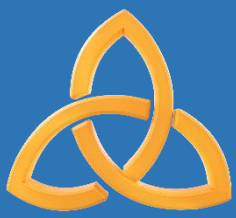
