

### Volunteers

Volunteers hand-pack these life-saving meals. More than half of FMSC volunteers are under the age of 18. Registration for volunteer shifts is online at fmsc.org

#### WHAT THEY DO

- Measure ingredients
- Pack food
- Prepare boxes for shipment



# Food Distribution Partners

Children in nearly 70 countries receive FMSC food. Worldwide Christian and humanitarian relief organizations partner with FMSC and distribute MannaPack Rice to children in various community settings: orphanages, schools, clinics, refugee camps, nutrition programs, and more.

### Cost

Each meal costs only 22¢ to produce

### **Donations**

Financial contributions allow FMSC to purchase ingredients. 93% of total donations to FMSC goes directly to the feeding program. Each meal costs 22¢ to produce, so donations of all amounts go a long way in the fight against world hunger.
