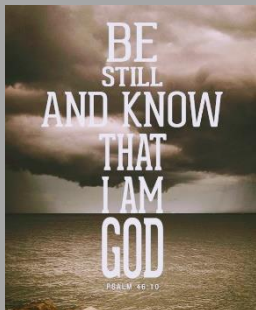

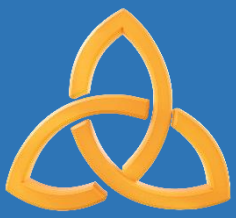

In the meantime, send me a picture of what you and the kids have been doing. I can add some to our weekly newsletter/updates.

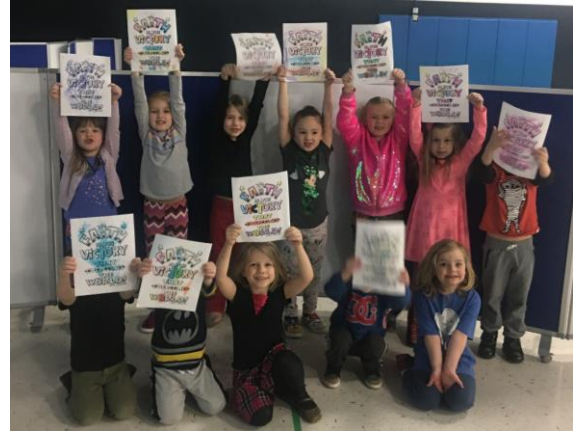
****King's Kids Challenge for March 26th-31st****
