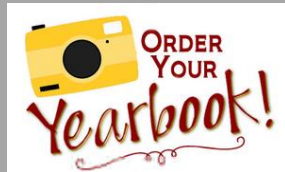

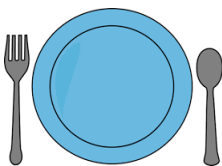
Yearbook Orders Due Today!

No Busing Tomorrow, Friday, May 7th

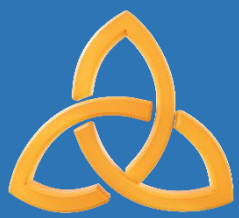

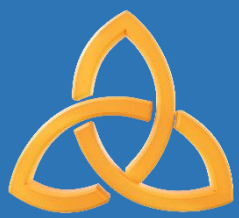

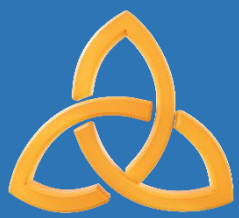

- Don't forget to change your spare clothes for summer. Also be sure to have closed toe shoes for our rocky playground. The summer calendar is attached.

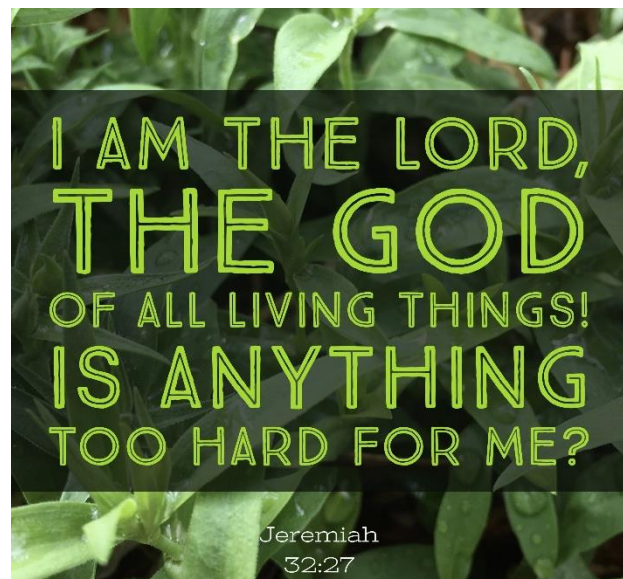
Thank You

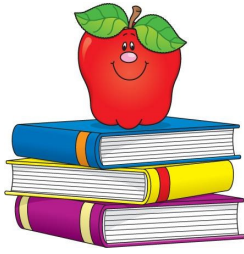
