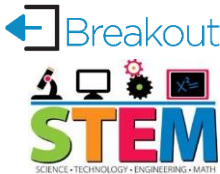

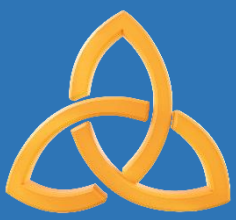

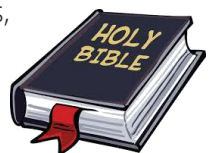
Book Exchange

Engineering Design Process
