If anyone could spare a box of Kleenex or 2, our supply is running low. There is a tub by the check in station to leave them.



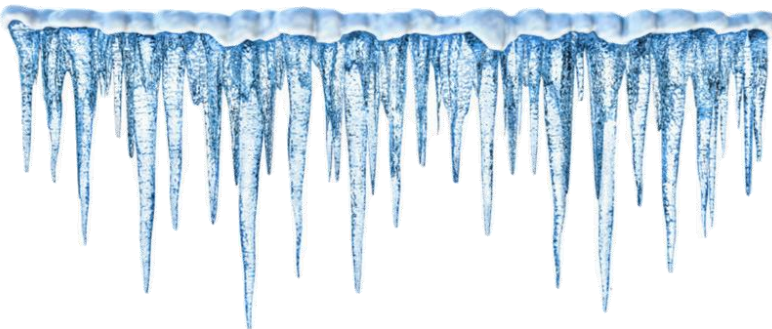
Brrr- Bundle Up!


